General Rules & Information

- The contest is open to individuals, children, families, youth groups and businesses.
- One entry only per person or group. One registration form per entry.
- Registration is required by Friday, November 29, 2013.
- All contestants must sign a release allowing Historic Perrysburg Inc. and the Way Public Library to use their name, likeness and entry in the organizations' newsletters and websites.
- Entries must be delivered to the Way Library no later than 7 p.m. Friday, December 8, 2018. Please bring your registration confirmation. All entries will be exhibited from December 8, through December 23, 2018.
- Decisions of the judges are final. Entries will be judged on creativity, neatness, and variety of material/details, use of color, setting, durability, and overall effect. Prizes will be awarded in all categories.
- An Awards Ceremony will be held on Saturday, December 23 at 1:00 p.m.
- Entries must be picked on December 23 before library closing. Any entries remaining thereafter will be discarded. Historic Perrysburg Inc. and the Way Library do not assume responsibility for any damage or loss.

Categories

- **Individual/Group/Family** - For children 14 and younger who work as a group or have adult assistance on **any** aspect of the entry. Maximum of 3 people working on a entry.
- **Adult Non-Professional** - Individual or group (1-3 persons max.), ages 15 and older, who are **not** certified chefs, working in the culinary arts, or are students of the culinary arts.
- **Adult Professional** - Individual or group (1-3 persons max.), ages 15 and older, who **are** professional chefs, working in the culinary arts, or are students of the culinary arts.

Guidelines

- Bases cannot exceed 19x14 inches.
- All building materials except base should be edible.
